Who We Are:

Mid-South Lions Sight and Hearing Service is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization. Our administrative offices are in Memphis, Tennessee, however the reach of our service extends to Tennessee, Arkansas, Mississippi, and Missouri. Mid-South has even treated patients from several other states and many foreign countries.

The mission of Mid-South Lions Sight and Hearing Service is to positively enhance the lives of the indigent sight or hearing impaired by providing light, sound, and hope through partnerships between Lions Clubs, medical professionals and facilities throughout the Mid-South.

Since 1942, Mid-South Lions Sight and Hearing Service has been restoring quality and independence to the lives of men, women, and children affected by preventable sight and hearing loss through a compassionate and comprehensive approach to opening avenues to costly medical care and assistance. Over 35,000 people have received the precious gifts of sight or hearing through our program. Many of these people do not have any alternative for receiving care.

There are many factors that combine to make our efforts possible, but the most important people and elements that enable us to complete our mission each day are:

- Donated time and service from Doctors, Medical Professionals, and Facilities

Our Headquarters: The Hamilton Eye Institute

From the youngest patient to the oldest, Mid-South Lions provides comprehensive vision and hearing care through our facilities in the Hamilton Eye Institute and our many other medical facilities throughout the area.



Our History:

- » In 1942, a group of Lions Club members from Memphis, with the cooperation of local ophthalmologists and hospitals, formed an organization whose sole purpose was to provide help to needy people in mid-America who had sight deficiencies. This group was known as the Mid-South Sight Conservation Association.
- » Since that time, the organization has grown to become the Mid-South Lions Sight And Hearing Service. As a federally registered not for profit organization, our main service areas include the states of Arkansas, Mississippi, Missouri and Tennessee.
- » Our main sight clinic is located in the Hamilton Eye Institute in Memphis and our hearing clinic is located in the Methodist Hospital Central in Memphis.
- » Our other sight facilities in Memphis include: Le Bonheur Children's Medical Center, Charles Retina Clinic, and Thomas Ocular Prosthetics and the University of Memphis Speech - Hearing Center. The Lions have also made agreements with facilities to create satellite clinics in Columbus, Mississippi and Fayetteville, Arkansas.
- » With collaborations with area medical professionals who donate their professional services, the University of Tennessee Ophthalmology's resident program, Methodist LeBonheur Healthcare and our other medical facilities and the Lions of the four state area, Mid-South Lions is able to provide about seven dollars in service for each dollar spent on patient care. As in 1942, Mid-South Lions does not accept government funding. Most of our financing comes from Lions Clubs, Foundations and Corporate Partners, Individuals and Special Events.
- » And to this day, Mid-South Lions Sight And Hearing Service provides all of its services at **NO CHARGE** to the patient. Participating Lions Clubs provide transportation and eyeglasses. All other charges are provided by Mid-South Lions Sight and Hearing Service.

What We Offer:

Mid-South Lions Sight and Hearing Service provides a wide range of medical services for the indigent sight and hearing impaired. Each of these services is geared towards curing preventable blindness and hearing loss, and include:

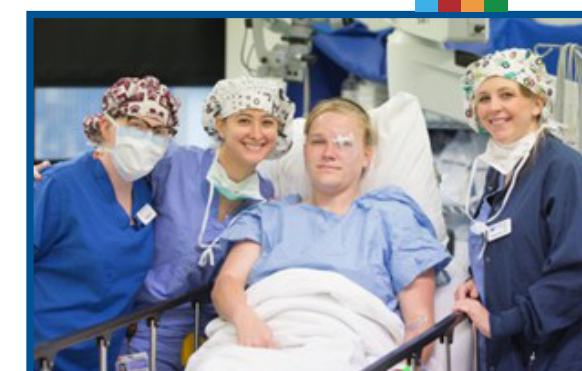
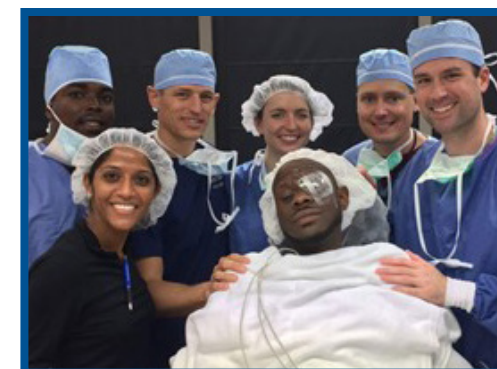
- Cataract Surgery
- Laser treatments for diabetic retinopathy
- Injections for detached retinas
- Glaucoma treatment
- Prosthetic Eyes
- Surgery for detached retina
- Low vision therapy
- Cornea Transplants
- Surgery for crossed eyes
- Hearing Aids
- And many other procedures and treatments

My name is Van. You assisted me with my application and approval for assistance from Mid-South Lions back in December 2023. I wanted to provide you with an update on my progress with the enucleation and prosthesis of my right eye.

Dr. Brian Fowler and the Hamilton Eye Institute (successfully) performed the enucleation (removal) of my right eye on December 28. I am very grateful to Dr. Fowler and the staff at Hamilton Eye Institute for the treatment and care I received.

Mr. Bob Thomas with Thomas Ocular Prosthetics Laboratories created my prosthesis for my right eye on February 19, 2024. The prosthesis is great. It is incredible how natural the prosthesis looks and resembles my other eye. The amount of movement the prosthesis has is amazing. Mr. Bob contacted me the next day to confirm that everything was going well with my prosthesis. Mr. Bob is a super nice man. I am totally amazed at the level of skill, talent and dedication that Mr. Bob brings to the table. He is one-of-a-kind and irreplaceable in my opinion. I have included a photo for your reference.

Ms. Ashley Fletcher, 33, has suffered from a pre-existing eye-disease for several years. Fletcher, who works for the Kutting Korner Salon in Hot Springs Village, AR, has been unable to obtain medical insurance coverage because of this condition.

With the assistance of Hot Springs Village Evening Lions, Fletcher had her first surgical procedure in early October at Mid-South Lions Sight And Hearing Service's Hamilton Eye Institute in Memphis, TN. She had surgery on one eye and had surgery on the other eye later.

Ashley helped Kutting Korner host a putting contest at the Village Lions October golf tournament and will attend a meeting of the club soon.

The HSVE fundraising efforts over the years allows people like Ashley to get the special care they need at Mid-South facility in Memphis, the Wallace Eye Center and St. Joseph Regional Medical Center in Hot Springs at no cost to the patient.



Members of the club are proud to be in a position to save the sight of a person who would not be able to receive this care without the Lions and Mid-South.
