The advanced technology and resources at Hamilton Eye Institute are best appreciated in person. Each year, we invite all members of the Lions community to experience Mid-South. This year, our board, staff, past presidents, medical partners, and Lions representatives from across our four-state region will have the opportunity to see, learn about, and experience the miracles Lions provide within the Hamilton Eye Institute.

The weekend program begins at 5:00 PM on Friday with hospitality and entertainment provided by representatives from all four states. At 7:00 PM, attendees will convene in the auditorium for the annual L. B. Baker Hall of Honor presentation and dinner.

Saturday's agenda starts at 8:00 AM with updates from our partners at the Hamilton Eye Institute on recent developments in ophthalmology, including significant advancements occurring regularly. Attendees will then tour the surgery center, pediatric clinic, and research floor, where efforts are ongoing to address visual health challenges. Following lunch, participants will hear testimonials from patients before the event concludes at 2:00 PM, allowing time to explore the sights and sounds of Memphis or return home.

Your investment of time and resources in Mid-South is valued, and VLW offers an excellent opportunity to observe the positive outcomes your support helps achieve. We are confident you will leave informed, inspired, and motivated with a deeper, understanding of how Mid-South serves your communities and supports individuals in need.
